Has a peppermint and floral fragrance, poached strawberries and cherry, a little pepper with some light cedar oak. It's medium bodied and fresh with good flavour, slightly tangy acids, light powdery tannin and decent length and flow. It's a good drink and a refreshing food style.

91 points. Terrific value here, with snappy red barbera fruits, some cherries and purple perfume, and a good serve of the regional mint slotted behind. On the palate, there's plenty of bright, chirpy red-berry fruit flavour; oak adds light vanillin and acidity ensures the fresh raspberry-pip finish lingers.
