Coonawarra

1996 Pinot Noir

While Coonawarra is not well known for its Pinot Noirs, there are two companies in the region which have been producing this variety for a number of years, and a decade of easy drinking Hollick Pinots precede this wine.

The wine is made from 100 % estate grown fruit, which displays the benefit of the long cool growing period which typifies Coonawarra.

Ten months in French and American oak has imparted some fine-grained tannins and slight toffee-like characters, which compliment the ripe cherry fruit flavours.

The balance of fruit, acid and tannin allows the wine to be enjoyed now, although cellaring for up to 5 years will allow flavours to develop and mature.

Light meats, pasta and spicy foods are ideal accompaniments to this wine.
