1997 Pinot Noir

Hollick Wines have a long established reputation for the production of Pinot Noir in Coonawarra. One of only two producers of this variety in the region, they aim to produce a wine with distinctive fruit characters. This is made possible by the ideal growing conditions experienced in Coonawarra.

The grapes were machine harvested in the cool of the morning, and immediately crushed and fermented under controlled conditions. Gentle pressing followed, and the wine was then matured in 1 year old French and American oak for twelve months. The oak has imparted some subtle nut and coconut characters, which harmonise with the cherry fruit flavours.

The wine may be enjoyed now or cellared for up to 5 years. The fruit, acid and tannin will soften over this time and marry together.

Light meats, pasta and spicy foods are ideal accompaniments to this wine.
