1999 Riesling

Hollick Wines remains one of a few producers committed to the production of varietal Riesling in Coonawarra. The long cool ripening season allows for the production of intensely flavoured wines possessing excellent cellaring potential.

The weather leading up to the 1999 vintage provided ideal growing conditions to produce fruit with intense Riesling flavours. The grapes, grown on our own vineyards, were harvested in the cool of the morning and immediately crushed and pressed to retain the primary fruit characters. The juice was cold settled for clarification prior to fermentation.

The colour of the wine is pale straw with greenish tinges. The wine displays typical floral aromas consistent with cool climate Riesling. This elegant, intensely flavoured wine displays trademark limey flavours with a touch of pear and apple balanced with tangy acidity.

Hollick Rieslings have demonstrated the ability to develop for 10 years or more in ideal cellar conditions, over time developing a deep golden colour and typical complex honeyed, toasty flavours.

The delicate flavours and texture combine well with grilled King George Whiting or Calamari Salad, and is delicious served lightly chilled as an aperitif.
