1997 Sauvignon Blanc Semillon

This wine is made from Sauvignon Blanc (60%) and Semillon (40%), grown on the Hollick Coonawarra vineyards. Hollick is one of only two producers of Semillon in the region. The decision to plant Semillon in 1994, stems from Ian Hollick's experience with the variety in the 70's with a vineyard upon which now stands the handsome Chardonnay Lodge complex.

In producing this traditional blend, the Hollick Winemaking team has captured the lively fruit characters for which Coonawarra and its cool climate is renowned. Sauvignon Blanc provides herbaceous and grassy flavours and lifted varietal aromas. Semillon has a balancing effect with more subtle tropical and citrus fruit characters.

The wine is flavoursome and well rounded, with a refreshing zesty finish. It has short term cellaring potential and can be enjoyed with a variety of foods, including seafood, vegetable antipasto and dishes with Asian influence. Serve chilled.
