The Wilgha Vineyard is to the west of the main Hollick vineyard holdings – a short drive down Ravenswood Lane. Lying on the famed terra rossa soil of Coonawarra, this vineyard is known to produce wines displaying distinctive regional and varietal characters. The Wilgha Vineyard Unoaked Chardonnay is made from 100% Chardonnay fruit grown on this vineyard.

With Coonawarra having one of the longest growing seasons in the world for Chardonnay, wines from this region display intense varietal fruit characters. The Wilgha Vineyard Unoaked Chardonnay is made in a style which ensures the retention of clean, fresh melon and tropical fruit characters. It finishes with a pleasing cleansing acidity.

The team from Hollick Wines recommend that the wine be enjoyed as a lively and zesty aperitif, or as an accompaniment to seafood or white meat dishes. Serve chilled and enjoy as a refreshing alternative to oak-matured wines.
