1999 The Wilgha Vineyard Unoaked Chardonnay

The Wilgha Vineyard Unoaked Chardonnay is a refreshingly light wine well suited to our modern alfresco lifestyle. It is delicious served as an aperitif or with a range of foods such as a Warm Chicken Salad or Chargrilled Octopus.

The Wilgha Vineyard lies at the southern end of the famed Coonawarra region, in the cool south eastern corner of South Australia. This vineyard produces wines which display distinctive varietal characteristics and excellent flavour intensity. These wines exhibit the benefits of a long cool ripening season and careful vineyard management to limit crop size.

The 1999 Wilgha Vineyard Unoaked Chardonnay was made employing methods to preserve the natural varietal flavours of the Chardonnay grape whilst retaining crisp acidity. The resultant wine is bursting with distinctive melon and tropical fruit flavours and aromas, finishing with refreshing cleansing acidity.

The team from Hollick Wines suggest that this wine is best consumed while youthful as a lighter alternative to oak-matured wines. Serve chilled or at cellar temperature.
